

3-DAY TRAINING IN BULGARIA

During 24.01.2019 – 26.01.2019 r. a 3-day training in Bulgaria for Bulgarian and Greek volunteers and representatives of project partners under the project “Protecting biodiversity at NATURA 2000 sites and other protected areas from natural hazards through a certified framework for cross-border education, training and support of civil protection volunteers based on innovation and new technologies”, acronym eOUTLAND, Subsidy contract № B2.6d.06/02.10.2017 was held in Complex „Perpera“, Stambolovo Municipality, Haskovo region. The training was hosted Project Beneficiary 3 RMA „Maritza“. The training was attended by 75 participants from Bulgaria and Greece.

For the effective organization of the training, RMA "Maritza" ensured: a hall for 75 people, provided with sound, multimedia; translation from and into Bulgarian, Greek and English; facilitators and lecturers; materials; catering.





The 3-day training in Bulgaria for Greek and Bulgarian volunteers and partners' representatives will be organized in the following panels:

- Personal safety and personal protective equipment (PPE), incl. safety and health requirements at work for volunteers members of Voluntary formations to prevent or manage disasters, fires and emergencies and mitigate their effects.

- Flood management in Bulgaria. The role of Volunteer formations in preventing or managing disasters, fires and emergencies and mitigating their effects. Practical guidelines and presenting examples from Haskovo region.

- Equipment and tools used in actions during floods. Providing operational flood protection. Involvement of Voluntary formations in Bulgaria.

- Presentation of the developed tools and their progress under the eOUTLAND project by Beneficiary 4 - Institute of Information and Communication Technologies - BAS

- Presentation of the envisaged equipment for the VF from Zlatograd Municipality, Beneficiary 5 on the project
- Presentation of the envisaged equipment for the VF from Haskovo region by RMA „Maritza“, Beneficiary 3 on the project
- Demonstration how to operate with the equipment and tools used in actions during floods. Outdoor practice.
