

## 3-DAY TRAINING "TRADITIONAL CULINARY AND WINES" IN GREECE WITHIN THE PROJECT "PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NATURAL AND CULTURAL HERITAGE OF BULGARIAN – GREEK CROSS-BORDER REGION THROUGH SMART AND DIGITAL TOOLS", ACRONYM "eTOURIST", SUBSIDY CONTRACT № B2.6C.07/09.10.2017

A 3-day training "Traditional culinary and wines" within the project "Promotion and development of natural and cultural heritage of Bulgarian – Greek cross-border region through smart and digital tools", with acronym "eTOURIST", Subsidy contract № B2.6c.07/09.10.2017 was held between 22/06/2020 - 24/06/2020 in Alexandroupolis, Greece. The training was organized by PB4 – Active Citizens Partnership (PB4).
